





ROSTER MATCH PROCEDURES & GAME REQUIREMENTS

"A" = Home Team

"B" = Away Team

- (1) Player "A" & "B": To remove the Red and Yellow Balls and place them at rack end of table and place the cue ball at baulk end of the table against the bottom rail.
- (2) Player "A": To clean the triangle and place the Red and Yellow balls in the rack in the correct order for play.
- (3) Player "B": To clean all the hard surfaces on the top of playing table.
- (4) Player "A": To clean any shared equipment used in their match i.e. "Cross or Spider Rests".
- (5) Players "A" & "B" are to then sanitize their hands & leave the playing area.
- (6) The next two (2) players then come to the table, the player who has the "Break" is to then "Rack the Balls" to the spot, remove the triangle and then break to start the frame.
- (7) The umpires only duty is to keep time & call any fouls, they do not touch any off the balls this includes the cue ball, after an in-off, the player who's turn it is, is to recover the ball from either the pocket or the ball tray.

At The End of Frame: The players who have just finished playing complete steps 1 - 5.

The two new players follow step 6 and a new umpire as per step 7.

Time taken: 2 minutes from end of frame to a new frame.
